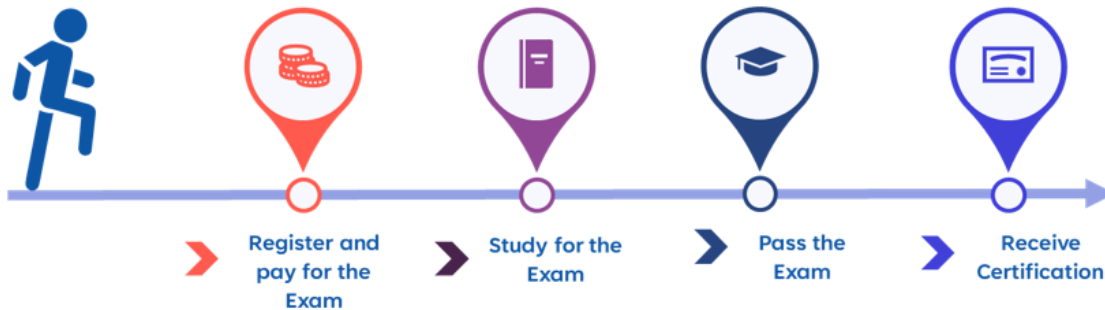
Step 1. Register and pay for the exam.
